NOT TO SCALE

- 1. THE CLEANOUT IS THE PROPERTY OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY.
- 2. THE CLEANOUT IN THE COMBINED SEWER SYSTEM AND SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM CONSISTS OF A P-TRAP, RISER, AND VENT.
- 3. THE CLEANOUT IN THE STORM SEWER SYSTEM CONSISTS OF A RISER AND VENT.
- PROPERTY OWNER SHALL SUBMIT SEWER CONNECTION PERMIT APPLICATION TO SFPUC FOR WORK THAT INCLUDES A CONNECTION TO THE EXISTING SEWER MAIN.
- 5. A MANHOLE IS REQUIRED AT POINT OF CONNECTION BETWEEN LATERAL AND SEWER MAIN FOR LATERALS 10" DIAMETER AND GREATER. UNLESS THE SEWER IS 42" DIAMETER OR GREATER.
