Grinding & Paving - 10-day Public Notice

Cratus, Inc. the contractor working for the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) on the new sewer and water main pipe replacement project (Contract No. WD- 2842) will begin the final grinding & paving of the existing asphalt streets along Yerba Buena Avenue, Casitas Avenue, Lansdale Avenue, Dalewood Avenue, Sherwood Ct, Hillcrest Ct & Myra Way. The existing asphalt streets will be ground out and new asphalt laid to repair the streets that have deteriorated during the waterline installation.

What to expect during Construction:

- The work will consist of grinding the existing asphalt streets to allow for new asphalt to be laid. There may be noise, vibration, dust, parking and traffic impacts in the work zone and disruption to normal neighborhood activity.
- The contractor will use No Parking signs & Tow Away signs to ensure the streets are clear of parked vehicles during the time of grinding and paving. It is important that vehicles are removed from streets so as they will not be towed.
- Access and parking will be reinstated at the end of the workday.
- The contractor can allow residents to and from their properties during this process. Please allow additional time to enter and exit your property during this period as this process involves heavy machinery.
- Parking will be prohibited in the work zone during work hours.

We apologize for the inconvenience caused by our work and will do all we can to minimize the impact on your neighborhood. If you have concerns (scheduled deliveries, accessibility needs, etc.) please contact the SFPUC representative below. We will do everything possible to find a mutually agreeable solution.
