TREE(S) TO BE REMOVED: (1) One

POSTING PERIOD (30 days) From: <u>10/23/2023</u> Through: <u>11/22/2023</u>

SFPUC proposes to remove 1 tree at the above location to construct the Channel Force Main Intertie Project to increase the reliability of the City's combined sewer system.

Members of the public who object to this action must protest in writing to the address below. Protests must be made within the posting period, or postmarked no later than, the last date of the posting period (above). If the tree removal is protested within the posting period, a public hearing will be scheduled.

REASON FOR REMOVAL: The new pipeline connection between two existing sewer facilities must cross under the tree for conveyance of flows. After analysis of alternative locations and in consideration of other, healthier trees, this location was identified as the optimal location for engineering criteria and minimal impact to local trees. The tree is in poor condition with mushrooms indicating internal wood decay.





TREE REPLACEMENT: Since the new pipeline connection will be sufficiently deep, the SFPUC will plant a new tree of similar species at this same location when construction is complete.
