


## Wawona and Vicente Street Stormwater and Water Main Improvements Scope and Upgrades

### **Project Benefits**

- Ensures citywide Level of Service for stormwater management in the area of 15th and Wawona streets
  - Important to note even after the project is complete, localized flooding is still a risk during major storms
- Add a water transmission line that serves as the Potable Emergency Firefighting Water Supply System (PEFWS), from 19th Ave to 25<sup>th</sup>
- Replacing aged water distribution main on Vicente and Wawona streets




## **Staging Areas for Tunneling Under Vicente**


Key elements of construction & staging for launch shaft

### **Coordination & Accessibility**

- Ongoing with SFMTA and DPW on site orientation, public safety, and accessibility
- Anticipated February start for 8-month duration
- Through access for bicycles in both directions
- Through access for pedestrians
- Closed to vehicular access
- Changing message signs posted in advance to notify of closure

## **Staging Areas for Tunneling Under Vicente**

Key elements of construction & staging for receiving shaft

#### **Coordination & Accessibility**

- Anticipated February start for 8-month duration
- Access for bicycles in both directions
- Access for vehicles in both directions
- Sidewalk and driveway access maintained
- No street parking
