# New Montgomery, Jessie, Minna, and Mission Street Brick Sewer Rehabilitation

## Our Sewer System Upgrades are Underway

The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) operates a combined sewer system that collects and treats San Francisco's wastewater (sewage and stormwater). Our Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP) is upgrading and modernizing our system to ensure we can continue to protect public health and the environment now and into the future.

As part of the SSIP investments, this project will rehabilitate the existing 100-year-old sewer main located under New Montgomery Street (between Market and Howard Streets), Jessie, Minna and Mission Streets (between 2nd and 3rd Streets), Jones Street (between Golden Gate Avenue and Market Street), Golden Gate Avenue (between Jones and Taylor Streets), Turk Street (between Taylor and Mason Streets), and Mason Street (between Eddy and Turk Streets). To minimize impacts to the roadway and adjacent residences and businesses, most of the sewer rehabilitation work will be performed using a trenchless method called Cured-in-Placed Pipe (CIPP) **sfpuc.org/curedpipe**. Construction will include improvements to sewer lower laterals within the project area. In some locations, street excavation will be required, and advance notice will be provided.

## What to Expect

- SEWER SERVICE in the area will NOT be interrupted during construction
- **PARKING:** Street parking will be impacted near construction zones. "No-parking" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance.
- **TRAFFIC:** Partial lane closures may be necessary to ensure safety of workers and the public. Advanced notice and detour signage will be provided as needed.
- MUNI: Passenger loading zone for buses may be affected. Advanced notice and detour signage will be provided as needed.
- ACCESS: Follow posted signage on site. Businesses and residents in the work zone will maintain access to their driveways and entrances during construction.
- NOISE: Neighbors may hear construction noise periodically. Noisy work will be conducted in compliance with the San Francisco Noise Ordinance.
- ODORS: If necessary, odor control measures will be in place during construction. Please see CIPP page for more information sfpuc.org/curedpipe.
- **NOTICE**: A 30-day and 10-day notice will be distributed prior to construction to residents and businesses within the project area.

### About the Sewer System Improvement Program

The New Montgomery, Jessie, Minna, and Mission Street Brick Sewer Rehabilitation Project is part of the Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP), a multi-billiondollar citywide investment required to upgrade our aging sewer system. The program is the result of an extensive community planning process and will ensure a reliable, sustainable and seismically safe sewer system now and for generations to come.
